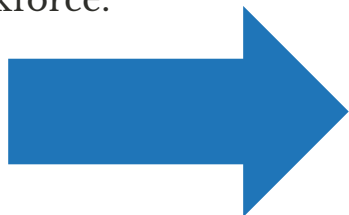
Apply now! Space is limited to the first 20 qualified applicants.

The KACTE Leadership Fellows Program is designed to provide professional development, policy knowledge and leadership development to new and current KACTE members.

Through the lens of the ACTE High Quality CTE Program of Study, the KACTE Leadership Fellows Program is designed to :

- provide a leadership development program for Kentucky CTE educators in KACTE and assist individuals in further developing their leadership skills in CTE
- create an opportunity for CTE educators to become familiar with and participate in the processes used by policymakers in the development and implementation of laws, regulations and other public policies at the local and state levels
- identify, train and motivate a cadre of leaders who will continue to position KACTE as a leader in developing an educated, prepared, adaptable and competitive workforce.



Full scholarships will be provided for those accepted into the KACTE Fellows program, including housing (double occupancy**) on 9/18/26 and 2/11/27, meals, breaks and all learning materials.

The KACTE Fellows are **required** to attend ALL THREE in-person sessions:



Session 1, Friday 5:30 p.m.-Saturday 4:30 p.m., September 18-19, 2026, Bowling Green

Session 2, Thursday 5:30 p.m.-Friday 4:30 p.m., February 11-12, 2027, Frankfort

Session 3, CTE Summer Program, July 19-22, 2027, Capstone Presentation, Galt House Hotel

Between sessions, virtual meetings will be held monthly with the Fellows Coordinators to assist Fellows in completing their Program of Work (Go to <https://bit.ly/KACTEFellowsPOW2425> for the 26-27 POW). Completion of Program of Work and participation in face-to-face sessions will entitle Fellows to a **\$250 stipend** as well as **24 Professional Development Hours or 12 EILA credits**.
